
## #061 Sinus Amoris

Sinus Amoris (<u>Latin</u> for "Bay of Love") extends northward from the northeast end of the <u>Mare Tranquillitatis</u>. It is located at selenographic coordinates 18.1° N, 39.1° E, and lies within a diameter of 130 km. To the north of the bay are the jumbled <u>Montes Taurus</u> peaks.

Near the southern end of the bay where it outlets into the Mare Tranquillitatis lies the crater <u>Theophrastus</u>. Along the western side is the flooded crater <u>Maraldi</u> and <u>Mons Maraldi</u>. Bordering the east side of the bay are the craters <u>Carmichael</u> and <u>Hill</u>. There are some low ridges in the central part of the bay, but otherwise it is relatively featureless.

At the southern egress where the bay joins the mare lies Mons Esam, a minor rise that lies among several small lunar domes.
